



“LYSAGHT INSPIRATION DESIGN AWARDS 2026” PROMOTION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

PROMOTER

2. The promoter is BlueScope Steel trading as Lysaght. ABN 16 000 011 058 of Tower B Level 4, 201 Coward Street, Mascot, NSW 2020, tel: (02) 9319 9000 (**Promoter**).

PROMOTIONAL PERIOD

3. The promotion commences on 09:00am 06/07/2026 and ends at 11:59pm AEST on 11/09/2026 (**Promotional Period**).

ELIGIBILITY

4. Entry is only open to residents of Australia aged 18 years or older who:
 - a) were the overall lead person (i.e. lead architect, building designer or specifier) responsible for the design of a completed building or restoration project (**Project**) and where the Project:
 - i. clearly incorporates verified LYSAGHT® or PERMALITE® building products (**Eligible Products**). For clarity this can be anything from the manufactured range. This can be purchased direct from Lysaght or via the distributor network; and
 - ii. falls within one or more of the four (4) Competition Categories set out below:
 - Residential Design
 - Commercial & Industrial Design
 - Regional Design
 - Resilient Building DesignEach a (**Competition Category**) and detailed further in clause 7 below.

For clarity the Project must be a complete Project. Projects that are in a design development phase, under construction or otherwise incomplete will not be deemed eligible for this promotion.

OR

- b) is currently enrolled in or have graduated in the last three (3) years from, a recognised architectural or building design curriculum at an Australian university, college or other educational institution and are responsible for a conceptual building project featuring LYSAGHT® or PERMALITE® steel building products (**Student Project**).

(together, **Entrants**).

5. The directors, management and employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, its related entities, printers, suppliers, providers and agencies who are directly associated with the conduct of this promotion are ineligible to enter the promotion. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto

spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin

CATEGORIES

6. There are four (4) Competition Categories and one (1) Student Category for the purposes of this promotion.

Competition Categories:

7. Entrants that meet eligibility criteria listed in Clause 4(a)(i) and 4(a) (ii), can submit their Project into any of the relevant Competition Categories. There will be one (1) prize awarded to the best judged Project in each Competition Category. A list of each Competition Categories and their description is set out below:

Residential Design: Recognising design in new houses, multi-residential buildings, alterations, additions, heritage, restoration & aged care dwellings;

Commercial and Industrial Design: Celebrating design in public, sporting, institutional, educational, retail & office buildings;

Regional Design: Acknowledging building design in regional Australia (for the purposes of the Competition Regional, areas are defined as those regions outside the capital city metropolitan areas in all states and territories);

Resilient Building Design: Acknowledging design and builds that consider resilient design principles.

Resilient buildings are described by Unesco as structures designed to withstand and recover from various hazards, including natural disasters. These buildings incorporate principles from disaster risk reduction to enhance their durability and adaptability. By using innovative materials and design techniques, resilient buildings aim to minimize damage, ensure occupant safety, and facilitate quicker recovery after adverse events.

Lysaght Inspirations Design Award:

8. There will be one (1) major prize awarded to the overall best Project submitted in the Competition Categories. The Entrant associated with the overall best Project will be deemed the Major Prize winner and the winner of the Lysaght Inspirations Design Award. For clarity, Projects submitted in the Student Category are not eligible for the Major Prize.

Student Category:

9. Entrants that meet eligibility criteria listed in Clause 4(b) can submit their Student Project into the Student Category. There will be one (1) prize awarded to the best judged Student Project in the Student Category.

Student Category: Open to conceptual building projects featuring LYSAGHT® or PERMALITE® steel building products designed by current students and recent graduates of architecture and building design.

HOW TO ENTER

10. To enter the promotion, Entrants must, during the Promotional Period:

- a) Visit <https://lysaght.com/inspiration/design-awards> (**Promotional Website**) and fully and correctly complete the online entry form in the manner required, including providing the Entrant's full name, residential address, email address and contact telephone number;
- b) When prompted provide the Project or Student Project* details including, where relevant, the Project name, the Project builder, Project owner, Project address, Suburb, State, Postcode and Country;
- c) if the Entrant is the employee or a contractor of a business or entity, the Entrant must state the Company name and ABN of the business or entity that employed them for the Project;
- d) nominate one or more of the Competition Categories in which to enter the Project, identify the LYSAGHT® or PERMALITE® products used in the Project and enter a Project description;
- e) upload the Application Materials (detailed below) to the Promotional Website; and then
- f) submit the fully completed online entry

(together, an **Entry**).

*Some details are not required for Student Project details submitted in the Student Category.

LIMIT ON ENTRIES

11. Only one (1) Entry is permitted per Student Project.
12. Entrants submitting a Project (other than a Student Project), may submit the Project into each of the four (4) Competition Categories so long as the Project is relevant to that Competition Category. Each Project can only be submitted into each Competition Category once and by the same Entrant. The Entrant must be the lead person on the Project. In the event of a disagreement as to who the Entrant is for a Project, the Promoter reserves the right to determine the Entrant.

COMPETITION CATEGORY APPLICATION MATERIALS

13. The Application Materials to be submitted by each Entrant submitting an Entry into a Competition Category include:
 - I. A project description in 500 words or less that provides the judges with an overview of the context of the Project including the building, the type of business the Project was designed for (if applicable), the Project's location and details of all Eligible Products used to design and build the Project; and
 - II. A series of files as follows:
 - (a) A copy of the Project site plan
 - (b) A copy of the Project roof plan (if LYSAGHT® Roofing product is featured);
 - (c) The Project Floor Plan;
 - (d) The Project key section
 - (e) Any line drawings or sketches of the Project, and any additional materials that will support the demonstrations of the design
 - (f) up to ten (10) original photographs of the Project, in which the Eligible Product is visible (where possible), supplied as JPEGs with a file size **no bigger** than 3MB; and

- (g) three (3) original high-resolution photographs suitable for publication, in which the Eligible Product is visible (where possible), as JPEGs with a file size of **at least** 3MB.

STUDENT CATEGORY APPLICATION MATERIALS

14. The Application Materials to be submitted by each Entrant submitting an Entry into the Student Category include:
- I. A Student Project description in 500 words or less, that provides the judges with an overview of the context of the building, how it responds to the awards design brief and details of all Eligible Products used in the design of the Student Project.
 - II. Supporting illustrations, renders, plans, drawings or similar documents that the Entrant feels necessary to most effectively communicate their design concept, including clearly identifying where Eligible Products have been used in the design of the Project. Where applicable, plans, line drawings of the Student Project and sketches of the Student Project, should be supplied as PDFs, with a maximum total file size of 128MB.

WINNER DETERMINATION

15. This is a game of skill, and chance plays no part in determining the winners.
16. At the end of the promotion, a panel of appropriately qualified judges will judge the Entries submitted in each Competition Category and Student Category and allocate each Entry a score out of 70(**Score**). Judging will take place at Tower B Level 4, 201 Coward Street, Mascot, NSW 2020. When judging the Entries and allocating a Score, the judges will consider the following:
- The Project meets the brief and fits into the relevant category
 - The use of Eligible Products within the Project
 - How well the Project meets the category description
 - Overall project appeal
 - Originality, creative merit and innovative use and incorporation of Eligible Products in the building design.

The Entrant that scores the highest Score in each Competition Category will each win \$5,000 cash (each a **Category Winner**). The Promoter will then award an additional \$10,000 to the Category Winner with the overall highest Score across all four (4) Competition Categories (**Major Prize**). For the avoidance of doubt, one (1) Category Winner will be awarded a total of \$15,000 and will be deemed the winner of the **Lysaght Inspirations Design Award**.

17. The Entrant that scores the highest Score in the Student Category will win \$2,500 (the **Student Winner**).
18. All prizes will be awarded by electronic funds transfer (EFT). Where a Category Winner is an individual entering in their own capacity, the prize will be awarded directly to that individual and paid into the individual's nominated Australian bank account in their name. Where a Category Winner is an employee of, or entered on behalf of, a business responsible for the relevant Project, the prize will be awarded to that business and paid into the business's nominated Australian bank account relating to that business. Any prize awarded to the Student Winner will be awarded directly to the Student Winner and paid into the Student Winner's nominated Australian bank account in their name.

Each winner or relevant business is responsible for providing full and accurate bank account details. The Promoter will not be responsible for incorrect details being provided, a banking institution rejecting an EFT payment, or any costs associated with locating any lost monies.

19. In the event of a tie between two or more Category Winners or a Student Winner with the same highest Score, the Promoter will judge the tied entries individually based on originality, creative merit and innovative use and incorporation of Eligible Products in the building design.

WINNER NOTIFICATION

20. The winners will be notified in writing via email within fourteen (14) business days of the judging. All reasonable steps to notify the winners of the results of the judging will be taken by the Promoter.
21. Each Entrant whose Entry is selected as a winning Entry must confirm their eligibility to receive the relevant prize in accordance with these Terms and Conditions within five (5) business days of being successfully notified by the Promoter. If the Entrant fails to confirm their eligibility by the date indicated by the Promoter, their Entry will be deemed invalid.
22. In the event that the Promoter cannot successfully contact an Entrant who submitted one (1) of the winning Entries within ten (10) business days of the judging, or in the event of an invalid Entry or an ineligible Entrant, or if the Entrant declines to accept a prize, the Promoter may, in its sole discretion, award the prize to the Entry with the next highest Score. The Promoter will continue this process until an Entrant has been successfully contacted and the Entrant has confirmed their eligibility to be awarded the prize.

CONTENT

23. Entrants agree that they are fully responsible for any materials they submit via the promotion including but not limited to Application Materials, comments, recordings and images ("**Content**"). The Promoter shall not be liable in any way for such Content to the full extent permitted by law. The Promoter may remove or decline to publish any Content without notice for any reason whatsoever. Entrants warrant and agree that:
 - (a) they will not submit any Content that is unlawful or fraudulent, or that the Promoter may deem in breach of any intellectual property, privacy, publicity or other rights, defamatory, obscene, derogatory, pornographic, sexually inappropriate, violent, abusive, harassing, threatening, objectionable with respect to race, religion, origin or gender, disparaging of any of the Promoter's or any prize supplier's products and/or services, not suitable for children aged under **15**, or otherwise unsuitable for publication or not in keeping with the spirit of the promotion;
 - (b) their Content shall not contain viruses or cause injury or harm to any person or entity;
 - (c) they will obtain prior consent from any person or from the owner(s) of any property or the Project that appears in their Content;
 - (d) they will obtain full prior consent from any person who has jointly created or has any rights in the Content to the uses contemplated by these Terms and Conditions, and the Content does not infringe the rights of any third party (including but not limited to intellectual property rights of any person including those existing in (but not limited to) any visible logos, drawings, cartoons, phrases, trade marks,

copyrighted material, mark that identifies a brand or other third party materials (excluding the Promoter);

- (e) they consent to any use of the Content which may otherwise infringe the Content creator's/creators' moral rights pursuant to the *Copyright Act 1968* (Cth) and warrant that they have the full authority to grant these rights; and
- (f) they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including without limitation, those governing copyright, content, defamation, privacy, publicity and the access or use of others' computer or communication systems.

Without limiting any other terms herein, the entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoter for any breach of the above terms.

- 24. As a condition of entering this promotion, each Entrant licenses and grants the Promoter, its affiliates and sub-licensees a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide, irrevocable and sub-licensable right to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish and display their Entry (which shall include Content) for any purpose, including but not limited to future promotional, marketing or publicity purposes, in any media, including in connection with the promotion of the relevant Awards during the Promotional Period and in subsequent communications, advertising, marketing and promotion relating to the Awards, the Awards winners and the Lysaght Inspirations Design Awards, without compensation, restriction on use, attribution or liability.
- 25. By entering the promotion, Entrants acknowledge that their Entry may be featured on the Promoter's Website and any other online platform (including social media platforms) or physical publication for public viewing for the duration of the Promotional Period and in perpetuity (unless otherwise requested).

VERIFICATION

- 26. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify to its satisfaction and in its absolute discretion that legitimate Eligible Products were used in the relevant Project or Student Project, and that the Entrant was responsible for the design of the relevant Project or Student Project. For the purposes of such verification, the Promoter may request any information or documentation it reasonably requires, including purchase records, invoices, specifications, plans, drawings, photographs, statements from the Project owner, builder, supplier, distributor or other relevant third party, and may, where reasonably necessary, inspect the Project on-site, subject to obtaining the permission of the owner or occupier where required. Any determination as to whether an Entry, Project, Student Project, Eligible Products or Entrant has been satisfactorily verified will be made by the Promoter in its absolute discretion.
- 27. The Promoter reserves the right to request the Entrant produce (within the requested time) appropriate photo identification or other documentation (to the Promoter's satisfaction, at its sole discretion) in order to confirm the Entrant's identity, age residential address, eligibility to enter and claim a prize, and any information submitted by the Entrant in entering the promotion, before issuing a prize. If any documentation required by the Promoter is not received by the Promoter (or its nominated agent) or an Entry or Entrant has not been verified or validated to the Promoter's (or its nominated agent's) satisfaction, then the Entries of that Entrant may be ineligible and deemed invalid.
- 28. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of any and all Entries and to disqualify any Entrant for: (a) tampering with the entry process; (b) submitting an Entry which is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions; or (c) engaging in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper

conduct of the promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

29. All Entrants acknowledge that the Promoter can rely on these Terms and Conditions even if the Promoter only learns of a person's ineligibility after the Promoter has awarded a prize to the ineligible person. Return of the prize or payment of its equivalent value to the Promoter may be required by the Promoter if this occurs.
30. A prize will only be awarded following any winner validation and verification that the Promoter, or its nominated agents, requires in their sole and absolute discretion.
31. Entrants who provide incorrect, misleading or fraudulent information are ineligible to participate in the promotion and all Entries of an Entrant who is deemed by the Promoter to have provided incorrect, misleading or fraudulent information may, at the discretion of the Promoter, be deemed invalid.
32. As a condition of accepting the prize, winners must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter and/or prize suppliers in their absolute discretion, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.

GENERAL

33. All of the Promoter's decisions in respect of the promotion are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
34. The Promoter's decision not to enforce a specific restriction (whether communicated to an Entrant or not), and/or to accept any error(s) and/or omission(s) on behalf any Entrant(s) does not constitute a waiver of that restriction or of these Terms and Conditions generally.
35. Entries will be deemed accepted at the time of receipt by the Promoter and not at the time of transmission by the Entrant. Entries received will be considered final by the Promoter.
36. Incomplete, inaccurate, erroneous, ineligible, unviewable or incompressible entries will be deemed invalid.
37. Entrants consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.
38. The use of any automated entry software or any mechanical, electronic or other means that allows an Entrant to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and will render all Entries submitted by that Entrant invalid. Costs associated with accessing the Promotional Website remain an Entrant's responsibility and may vary depending on the Internet service or telecommunications provider used.
39. these Terms and Conditions or any other legal obligation by an Entrant, the Entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoter for those losses, damages and costs.

40. If this promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, including but not limited to technical difficulties, unauthorised intervention or fraud, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law: (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate.
41. Liability for any tax (other than FBT) arising out of participation in this promotion (including acceptance of a prize) is the sole responsibility of the Entrant. Entrants should seek independent financial advice in this regard.
42. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia ("**Non-Excludable Guarantees**"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.
43. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any Entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or Entrant; or (f) use of a prize.

PRIVACY

44. The Promoter collects personal information ("**PI**") in order to conduct the promotion and may, for this purpose, disclose such PI to third parties, including but not limited to agents, contractors, service providers and prize suppliers. Entry is conditional on providing this PI. The Promoter will also use and handle PI as set out in its Privacy Policy, which can be viewed at <http://www.lysaght.com/privacy-policy>. In addition to any use that may be outlined in the Promoter's Privacy Policy, the Promoter may, for an indefinite period, unless otherwise advised, use the PI for promotional, marketing, publicity, research and profiling purposes, including sending electronic messages or telephoning the Entrant. The Privacy Policy also contains information about how Entrants may opt out, access, update or correct their PI, how Entrants may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other applicable law and how those complaints will be dealt with. All Entries become the property of the Promoter. The Promoter will not disclose PI to any entity outside of Australia.
