Emergency Procedures – Call the Departmental Emergency Controller (DEC) on (02) 8856 8638 and inform them of the emergency.

In an emergency, the DEC (identified by a yellow helmet) will control the situation. In the case of an evacuation you will hear an alarm. Personnel should remain calm, ensure the work area is left in a safe condition and evacuate the building immediately in a safe and orderly manner via the nearest exit using walkways. Proceed to the designated evacuation 'emergency assembly area'.

Remain at the assembly point until the DEC has checked your name off and do not leave or return to the work area until instructed by the DEC.

Site Access



- Entry to site is via the 'Truck Entry' gate off Templar Road.
- Press the red button on the intercom and give a brief explanation for your visit to site.
- All vehicles are to park in front of the roller doors (do not pass the red line) and engines must be switched off upon exiting the truck cabin.
- All drivers are to report to Despatch.



Site Safety Procedures & Requirements

Inductions	-All drivers and accompanying personnel must be inducted and a walk-around must be completed prior to commencing any work on siteInductions are valid for 3 years.	
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)	-All PPE including long sleeve cotton drill shirts, pants, safety helmet (cannot be yellow), clear safety glasses, gloves and safety boots are required to be worn at all times upon entering WSSC building.	
Drug, Alcohol & Smoking Policy	-Smoking is not permitted on siteAlcohol & illicit drugs are not to be brought onto site, nor consumed prior to arrival on siteRandom drug & alcohol testing is conducted on a regular basis – YOU may be asked to participate.	
Mobile Phone Use	-Only use your phone where it is safe. Phones must not be used when driving, walking, loading/unloading, restraining loads or within mobile equipment hazards zones.	
Speed Limits	-20km/h outer ring road10km/h everywhere else including car park and work areas.	
Walkways	-GREEN walkways provide the safest means of walking around siteBLUE areas are 'work areas' and are only accessible after drivers have been inducted. Inducted drivers are only allowed in the blue truck loading bays at either end of the building (i.e. Crane 4 & Crane 5 Loading End)YELLOW & BLACK walkway crossings mean mobile equipment and cranes have right of way.	
Boom Gates	-Boom Gates and barriers have been installed around site. These gates are controlled by BlueScope staff ONLY. Do not open at any time.	
Mobile Equipment Hazard Zones (MEHZ)	-Mobile Equipment Hazard Zones (MEHZ) are identified by a Yellow & Black borderTrucks, forklifts and cranes are mobile equipment and must not enter a mobile equipment hazard zone if a person is in thereWhen mobile equipment is operating in the zone, other mobile equipment or person must not enter the zone.	




Loading/Unloading Procedures

Entering the Building to	-Upon entering despatch, you will receive instruction regarding your
Load/Unload	load, which end you will be loading/unloading at (crane 4 or 5) and
	when it is safe for you to enter the WSSC factory building.
	-Await boom gate to be opened by despatch personnel.
	-Before entering the WSSC building you should check that cranes are
	parked or away from the loading bays.
	-Stop and sound your horn prior to entering the building.
	-Park in the centre of the 'Mobile Equipment Hazard Zone'.
	-Drivers MUST switch off their engines and exit their vehicles.
Loading or Unloading Vehicles	-Drivers are permitted to set up their trailers in the bay or prior to
	entering the building depending on the circumstances and advice
	from despatch personnel.
	-Drivers ARE NOT ALLOWED to climb onto their decks/trailers at any
	time unless proper fall protection is used i.e. platforms and restraint
	belt/harness.
	-Drivers are to stay in the green driver safe zone and be visible to the
	crane drivers once loading/unloading begins.
	-If a driver needs to approach their trailer to verify the position or
	adjust equipment they MUST gain permission from the crane driver
	via radio communication and the crane inhibit light must be on
	(flashing red).
Restraining Your Load	-Mobile platforms must always be used when working on trailers to
3 11 111	restrain your load.
	-Platforms must be positioned alongside the trailer and a minimum of
	6 brakes must be engaged.
	-Restraint Belt/Harness must be worn and attached to lanyard –
	unless both platforms are used.
	-If driver is not using the restraint belt/harness, they may use a
	platform on both sides of the trailer ensuring 6 brakes on each
	platform are engaged.
	-Chin straps must be worn on safety helmets when working on
	trailers/decks.
	-All loads are audited against BlueScope Load Restraint Guidelines.
	Trucks are not permitted to leave warehouse without correct load
	restraint.
	All drivers must tarp or chain under new external enclosure
	from Bay 2.
